COACHES AND OFFICIALS

It's that time of year again to start thinking about taking SafeSport and renewing your membership for 2018. If you renew your membership by December 31, 2017 you will only have to take the 30-minute SafeSport revision test. However, if you wait and renew after that date then you will have to take the full 2-hour SafeSport test all over again. There is a link to follow on our website at www.usaboxingnewengland.org or you can go directly to <http://www.teamusa.org/USA-Boxing/Membership/Registraion> and click on Renew Your Membership.

To be considered a registered coach you must renew membership plus complete and pass SafeSport. If you have not completed and passed SafeSport, then you will not be considered registered and will not be allowed to work anyone's corner until you do so.

To be considered a registered official you must also renew your membership, complete and pass SafeSport plus you must fill out an application for the State of Massachusetts (if you're already a registered Pro Official then you do not have to do this) for a link to the form can be found at mass.gov/service-details/msac-applications-for-participant-license and click the one for Judge. Please print and fill out the application also put on the top of the form "Amateur Official" this ensures there is no fee associated with it then you need to physically hand it to the Chief of Officials Stephen Clark. Once your application has been received then you will be considered fully registered for 2018. However, if you do not complete all the requirements then you will not be considered registered and you will not be allowed to work any shows until you do so.
